The VW Beetle is an air cooled vehicle, there is no cooling system other than the air passing over the engine and keeping your oil cool. Therefore oil is the life blood of your engine. There is nothing that will ruin an engine faster than low oil or no oil in the engine, the only exception perhaps being a tight valve.

Hi! I probably shouldn't have, but I bought a Burro buggy with a bill of sale. I would like to legalize the car in MI. The bill of sale says the chassis is a VIN #3602294 and supposedly a 1963 VW Beetle. The engine carries a # AK089411 and is supposed to be a 1974 1600. I found the engine number, but cannot find the chassis # anywhere.

How to decipher your VW Beetle engine and chassis numbers ...

The Type 3 was initially equipped with a 1.5 L (1493 cc) engine based on the air-cooled 1192 cc flat-4 found in the Type 1, but given a 69 mm stroke it became the basis for the 1300 cc and 1600 cc engines that followed in the later Beetle (Type 1) and Volkswagen Type 2 T1 and T2. [citation needed] While the long block remained the same as the Type 1, the engine cooling was redesigned by ...
