Rules for Opener (the first player to make a bid other than Pass). Your first bid: Always open the bidding at the 1-level if you have at least 13 points You may open a hand of 11 or 12 points if you have a long suit, distributional strength and/or good quick tricks. The meanings of your opening bids are: 1NT = Exactly 15-17 points and balanced distribution (at least 2-3 cards in every suit).

With only 15 words allowed during an auction and just 13 cards in each suit, bridge players have invented dozens of special bids, called conventions, to describe their strength and hand patterns. These descriptions are from the ACBL Bridge Bulletin series called the Bidding Toolkit.
