If the source is central to your work, you may want to introduce it in a separate sentence or two, summarizing its importance and main ideas.

Primary sources are original, first-hand documents such as creative works, research studies, diaries and letters, or interviews you conduct. List the author's name and date of publication. Start your Reference List entry with the author's last name, followed by a comma and a space. Then type the author's first initial (and middle initial, if given). Separate the names of multiple authors with commas, placing an ampersand (&) before the last author's name.
