Through hands-on practice, clinical supervision and academic study, CPE students are chaplain interns who learn how to listen and attend to patients more effectively. For instance - how to engage patients and their loved ones, establish rapport and maintain eye contact, pay attention and respond to both verbal and non-verbal communications, and better understand what they are observing during encounters.

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) offers supervised experience in pastoral care. CPE experience is highly recommended in preparation for careers in congregational ministry, chaplaincy and counseling and is generally offered in hospital settings, though outpatient and congregational settings are also available.

Group and clinical work and individual supervision will be Mondays through Fridays, 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. One weekend monthly you will be the day chaplain (8:00-4:30) for the entire hospital. Pre-requisite for entering the residency is a graduate theological degree or sufficient progress toward it that could be certified as a chaplain within 24 months of completing the residency.

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is graduate-level theological and professional education for ministry that takes place in a clinical setting. CPE trainees learn the art and skills of pastoral care by providing support to patients, families and staff, and then reflecting on their ministry experiences with a certified CPE Diplomate Supervisor and a small group of peers.

CPE is about change, transition and transformation and involves peer and individual supervision as part of the action-reflection process. CPE is designed to call forth, recognize, and strengthen an

individual's unique gifts in ministry in dialogue with one's spiritual heritage and the behavioral sciences.

Whether pastoral supervision is understood as the supervision of pastoral work or by the commitments of the person offering the supervision. In the end the latter route was chosen, allowing for NHS contexts in which chaplains might, for example, supervise nurses whose practice is not necessarily pastoral in a theological sense.
