### Details - Comparative physiology of the brain and ...

In the field of drug discovery, retrometabolic drug design is a strategy for the design of safer drugs either using predictable metabolism to an inactive moiety or using targeted drug delivery approaches. The phrase retrometabolic drug design was coined by Nicholas Bodor. The method is analogous to retrosynthetic analysis where the synthesis of a target molecule is planned backwards.

Increase in behavioral complexity The effect of increased relative brain size on behavior is one of the thorniest issues in comparative neurobiology. Late in the 19 th century, relative brain size was believed to be linked to intelligence (Marsh, 1874; Romanes, 1883).
