The goal of Family Finding is to connect each child with a family, so that every child may benefit from the lifelong connections that only a family provides.

Preparing Children and Youth for Permanency - Child ...

Pennsylvania recently passed legislation mandating family finding for all children and youth upon entry into care and at least annually during their stay in foster care. Preparation is also essential for parents, family members and kin to be ready to provide permanency for a youth, just as it is essential to prepare youth for permanency.

The Fostering Connections to Success and Increasing Adoptions Act of 2008 (P.L. 110-351) recognized the importance of connections between children in foster care and their kin, and Congress authorized \$75 million over 5 years for grants to enable states, tribes, and nonprofit organizations to implement programs to increase permanency for children and youth, including relative search and engagement programs such as "intensive family finding."

Finding permanency for youth in out-of-home care is paramount because it provides them with stable, life-long, family relationships. Child welfare agencies, in partnership with the larger community, have a moral and professional responsibility to find a permanent family for these youth.

Northstar Care for Children. The Northstar Care for Children Act is a new state law which takes effect Jan. 1, 2015. It makes significant changes in programs creating a uniform set of benefits and processes for children age 6 and older in foster care, former foster children whose legal custody has been transferred to a relative, and former foster children who have been adopted.

Keeping more children and youth safe through family preservation and finding permanency for CYIC will influence the rate of CYIC downwards. One of MCFD 's main goals this year (goal 1 in the 2018/19-2020/21 service plan) is to address the root cause of the over-representation of Indigenous children in care.

When you are not in court you will likely be attending multiple permanency placement hearings at a local CPS office. These meetings involve you and all of the other parties to your case discussing where your child will be living during the case and what is in your child's best interests for a post-investigation home.

Finding permanency for your child in a Child Protective ...

The Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) will identify and recommend to the court a Permanency Plan for every child adjudicated as a Child in Need of Services (CHINS). A second Permanency Plan will be identified if Concurrent Planning is appropriate (see policy 5.15 Concurrent Planning).

Permanency refers to a child exiting from CPS care into an appropriate, permanent setting. CPS's goal for children and youth in conservatorship is Positive Permanency. Positive Permanency is when a child or youth exits to:

6200 Case Planning for Positive Permanency

Educate involved professionals about permanency on a regular basis. Determine how to involve partners, including the youths' attorneys, youth advocates, juvenile court, mental health, probation, group homes, foster family and adoption agencies. Finding permanence requires a team approach with staff, collaterals, and family sharing the work.
