In general, we can divide the collection of geographic data into two main types: Directly collected data; Remotely sensed data; Directly collected data are generated at the source of the phenomena being measurements such as temperature readings at specific weather stations, elevations recorded by visiting the location of interest, or the position of a grizzly bear equipped with a GPS-enabled collar.
