The K4 has 3 drill-bit guides, making it possible to drill multiple pocket holes without moving the board. When clamped, you simply drill the pocket hole using these bit guides, with the special stepped drill bit that comes with the jig. Then unclamp, slide the board down, and repeat. Or remove the board, place the new board, clamp and repeat.

The Drill Bit and Screws. A pocket hole's stepped drill bit has a narrow tip to guide the screw and a wider part to bore the pocket hole. A regular screw would likely blast all the way through the pocket hole. A pocket screw has a wide head that rests on the little "shelf" made by the bit.

Drill pocket holes so screws thread into edge or face grain for maximum purchase; avoid screwing

into end grain, as shown below. These screws won't hold as well threaded into end grain. Instead, drill the pockets on the rail and drive screws into edge grain of the stile.

The interior of the workpiece should be facing you to receive the pocket holes. Remember that the screws need to go into the side of the receiving piece, not into end grain (see Tip). Slide the drill bit into the correct guide hole and drill the pocket hole in one smooth in and out motion with the drill on high speed.

I agree with Ander, a true "pocket" hole consists of a pilot hole the size of the screw shank, and a counter bore slightly large for the head of the screw to seat on. Tightening the screw against the flange of the counter bore is where the strength of the joint is determined.

Drill the pocket hole. A special step drill bit not only drills the pocket hole, but it also drills the guide hole for the screw in one quick motion (for more on step bits, see our Drill Bits Buying Guide). Simply clamp the pocket hole jig securely to your wood, and drill the hole.

When joining with pocket screws, turn the boards upside down on a flat surface and clamp the two boards to the flat surface to align the top sides of the boards(now facing down) before fastening with the pocket screws.

Self-Tapping Screws Keep It Simple. The pocket hole makes this type of joint possible, but it's the Kreg Pocket-Hole Screw that pulls it all together. As you drive the screw in, the pocket and pilot hole guide the screw precisely, while the screw's self-tapping tip drills its own hole into the mating piece.

A pocket hole is, in a nutshell, a hole drilled at an angle that forms a "pocket" for the screw. The pocket hole is an advanced and precise toe-nailing that involves the pocket hole jig, which allows us to drill into the wood at an angle to produce the pocket to house the screw head. The pocket hole screws, on the other hand, are designed as a joint between two adjacent boards. The idea is to have both boards to have the angled pockets drilled to them to hide the screws from sight. Since ...
