When we shoot in manual mode, we choose the setting of each of those three elements, to create a balance that results in our desired exposure and our artistic vision. So we need to examine the exposure triangle and gain an understanding of how each element captures light, and what effect each one has on the photo. Only then can we make decisions on our settings for the purpose of avoiding problems such as images that are too dark, too light, or out of focus, etc.
