Evaluation and management (E/M) coding is the use of CPT ® codes from the range 99201-99499 to represent services provided by a physician or other qualified healthcare professional. As the name E/M indicates, these medical codes apply to visits and services that involve evaluating and managing patient health.

Initial Hospital Care (99221-99223) These codes are used to bill for initial hospital services otherwise known to physicians as H&Ps. When you admit a patient to the hospital as in inpatient, these are the codes you will use.

Level 3 Hospital Progress Note (99233) The 99233 represents the highest level of care for hospital progress notes. This is the second most popular code selected by internists who used the 99233 level of care for about 40% of these encounters in 2012.

In this case, the appropriate "inpatient" E/M code (e.g. 9922x, 9923x, 9925x) represents the "primary" service. Code 99356 is reported during the first hour of prolonged services, beyond the initial encounter time, and 99357 is used for each additional 30 minutes of prolonged care beyond the first prolonged care hour.

To group diagnoses into the proper DRG, CMS needs to capture a Present on Admission (POA) Indicator for all claims involving inpatient admissions to general acute care hospitals. Use the UB-04 Data Specifications Manual and the ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting to facilitate the assignment of the POA indicator for each "principal" diagnosis and "other" diagnoses codes ...
