Your exposure will depend upon the lighting in your scene. A good starting place is to set the ISO to 400, aperture to f/5.6. Because you'll likely want to control the sharpness of the background, set the camera's mode dial to Aperture Priority. In this mode, you set the Aperture, and the camera selects the corresponding shutter speed.

Using the front dial will allow changing bracketing steps and the rear dial will change the number of frames shot in a bracketing sequence. The Nikon D500 allows bracketing up to 9 frames and up to 3 stops (EV) apart. However, in order to do 3 EV bracketing, you can only enable 5 frames of bracketing or fewer.

How to Use the Nikon D3300 - Tips, Tricks and Manual ...

Instead of setting the ISO to be at 400 or 800, it's wise to set it to Auto ISO and select the maximum sensitivity to be 800. If you are using a full-frame camera (like Canon 1DX, 5DMark3, Nikon D4, D810, etc.), you can set the maximum sensitivity to ISO 1600 (or even 3200 depending on noise levels). Auto ISO settings for Canon DSLRs:

Look through your viewfinder and point your camera at a nearby object or person. Press the shutter button half way down to focus, then lift up again. Don't yet take the shot. Still looking through your viewfinder, look for the exposure line along the bottom.

Tips for manual mode camera settings - SLR Photography Guide

The lower the ISO number, the more light is required to get a good exposure on your photographs and the less noise you will see in your resulting images. Higher ISO numbers allow you to shoot better quality photos in lower light conditions, but the more noise you may see in the background of your images.
