Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a developmental and neurological disorder that affects how a person perceives, socializes, communicates and behaves. The term "spectrum" is used because patients can have a wide range of symptoms that begin in early childhood and may last through adulthood. There is no cure for ASD, but treatment can be effective in managing symptoms, including difficulty communicating with others and repetitive behaviors.
