Paternity will not be established until the judge signs the Decree and the Decree is filed with the clerk of the district court. Please refer to the Instructions for Completing the Complaint for Paternity, Custody, Parenting Time, and Child Support (DC 6:8.3a) for details on how to fill out the Complaint.

Establishing Paternity, Custody, Parenting Time, and Child ...

If the mother and father are not married when the child is born, the child's father can fill out and sign the Paternity Acknowledgment form (also called the DH-511) in the hospital. Both parents must fill out and sign the form in the presence of a notary public provided by the hospital.

Florida Dept. of Revenue - Establishing Paternity

A voluntary declaration of parentage or paternity is a California governmental form that, when signed by both parents, establishes them as the legal parents of the child. The form must be signed voluntarily.

If the parents are not in agreement that the alleged father is the biological father, the mother must complete and submit a Paternity Affidavit (PDF) » to begin a legal process that usually includes genetic testing. Once a Paternity Affidavit is received, the Child Support Program attempts to establish

paternity or a child support order.

The mother or alleged father may also ask the court to order genetic tests, but they must then file an Affidavit(sworn statement) alleging or denying paternity and stating facts that show there is a reasonable possibility that there was or was not sufficient sexual contact between alleged father and the child's mother to conceive a child.

Unmarried parents can ask the local family court to help establish paternity. This usually involves DNA paternity testing (also referred to as genetic testing). MDHHS - Paternity Establishment

A paternity affidavit is a legal document that permits a man and a woman to declare, under penalty of perjury, that the man is the biological father of a child. A properly executed paternity affidavit establishes legal paternity (fatherhood) and parental rights and responsibilities, without the necessity of obtaining a court order.

DCS: Paternity - Indiana

The declaration of parentage or paternity MUST be signed at one of these public agencies (unless it has been signed at the hospital) or witnessed by a notary public. Most public agencies that have the declaration forms also have a short video explaining how the voluntary declaration of parentage or paternity works.
