The concept behind The Rite of Spring, developed by Roerich from Stravinsky's outline idea, is suggested by its subtitle, "Pictures of Pagan Russia in Two Parts"; the scenario depicts various primitive rituals celebrating the advent of spring, after which a young girl is chosen as a sacrificial victim and dances herself to death.

The Rite of Spring in the 21st Century - Just like Beethoven's 9th Symphony changed the future of symphony composition, Stravinsky's Rite of Spring changed the future of ballet. The Rite of Spring is perhaps German dancer and choreographer Pina Bausch's most seminal work. Performed on stage covered with a layer of earth, the production left the cast "sweat-streaked, filthy and audibly panting" according to The Guardian 's Luke Jenning.
