Card Weaving and Andean Sling Braids. Andean sling braids are typically square braids. Their structure is a three dimensional twining structure, where warp becomes weft and weft becomes warp again. If a square braid is made with 32 threads, a single side may have the appearance of a card woven band made with four cards.

### OTHER CRAFTS: Basketry, Beading, Braiding, Etc.

The people of the Andes have used slings, or hondas, for thousands of years to protect their flocks of alpaca and llama. Men and women traditionally braid hondas of thick yarn made of llama wool, which is thicker and courser than alpaca. Llama wool produces yarn only good for rough textiles such as potato sacks and hondas.
