Manual: In a manual transmission, the problem is not so much the fluid degradation, but rather fluid contamination. This contamination occurs over time as the synchronizers, bearings and gears in the transmission wear out. The resulting metal particles then float around in the lubricant.

The listed capacity of the manual transmission oil is 1.7L 1.8Qts. I just replaced the output shaft seal using the Pelican Parts article & added new fluid. The transmission took 2L without leaking from the fill hole. Car was level. Took it to the dealer for a check and they added 0.25L more. So now there is 2.25L in the transmission.
